August is Children's Eye Health & Safety Month

learning challenges may actually have vision problems. While an annual eye exam for your child is the best preventive measure, there are several things to watch for to help determine whether your child is having vision problems:

- Do your child's eyes appear crossed or uneven? Are eyelids red-rimmed, crusted, or swollen? Are their eyes watery or red? These are all causes for concern and should be checked out.
- Is your child frequently rubbing eyes or closing or covering one eye? Do they blink or squint more than usual? Do they hold objects close to their face to see them? These are all signals of a possible problem.
- If your child complains of frequent headaches, dizziness or nausea it can signal a vision problem rather than illness.


